

BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners of the Burlington School Board urge our Governor and the State Legislators to allocate school modernization and improvement money from the stabilization funds provision of the A.R.R.A. that would assist us and many other Vermont school districts to meet the long deferred infrastructure needs of our schools.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the Commissioners of the Burlington School District express their determination to provide for the least restrictive learning environment and full accessibility to all Burlington school facilities, meeting the intent of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (I.D.E.A.) and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). The Board, recognizing the special significance of the Edmunds Elementary and Middle Schools in the fabric of our city and the need for these schools to welcome every person, directs administrators to aggressively seek funds from any and all applicable sources, including the A.R.R.A. as soon as possible.
