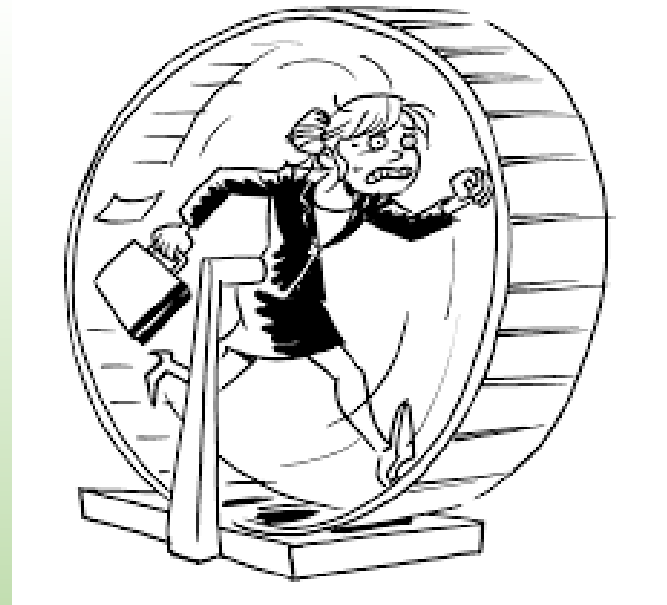

Goal of Strategic Planning Process

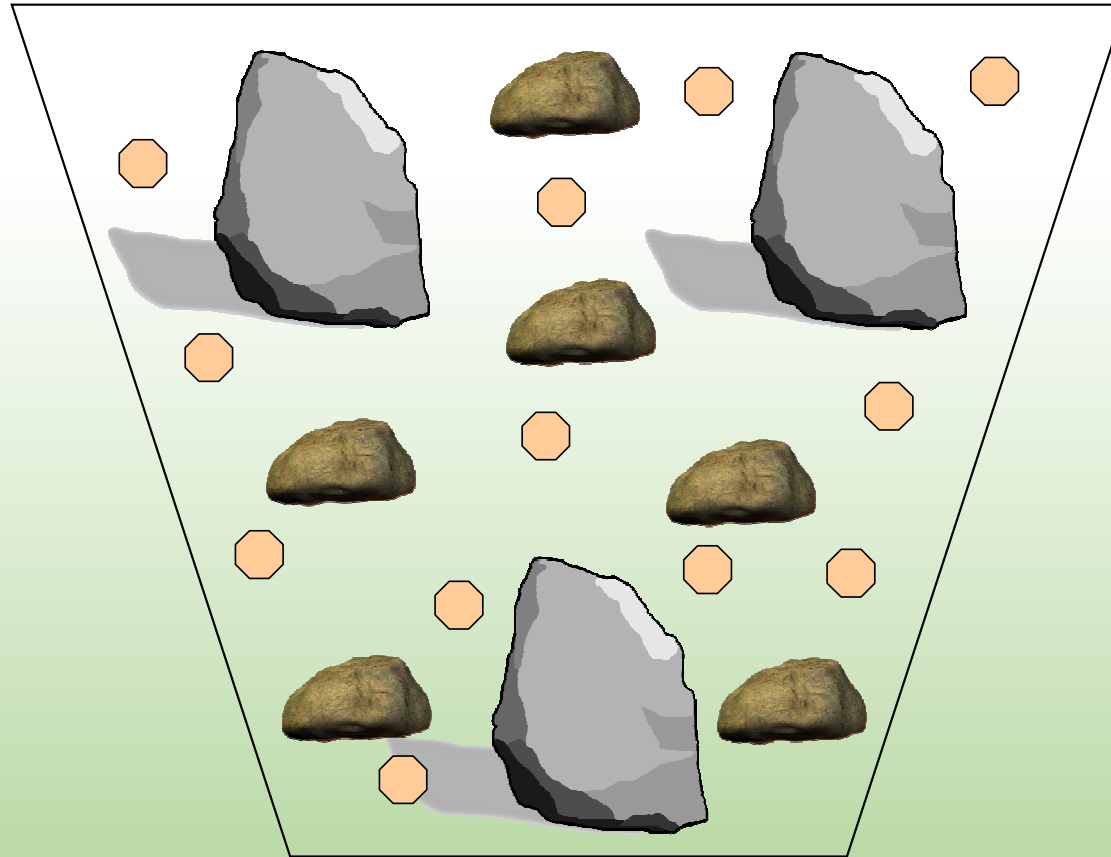
The end goal is to have a four-year strategic plan which reflects our community values. This plan will be used to resource District priorities.

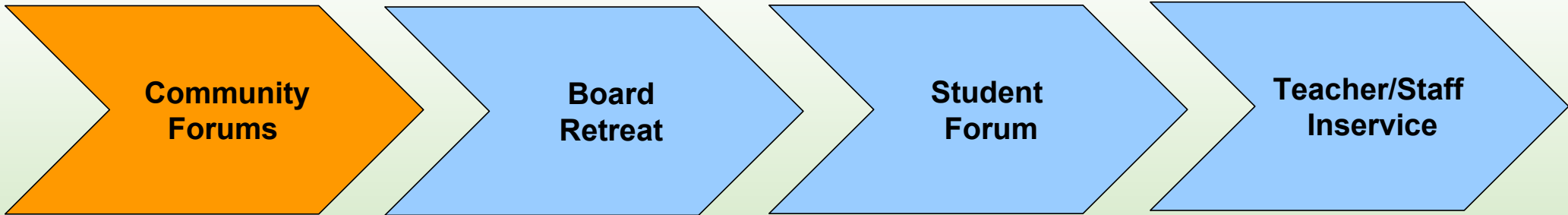

Strategic Planning Process Overview/Timeline (Consultation Phase)

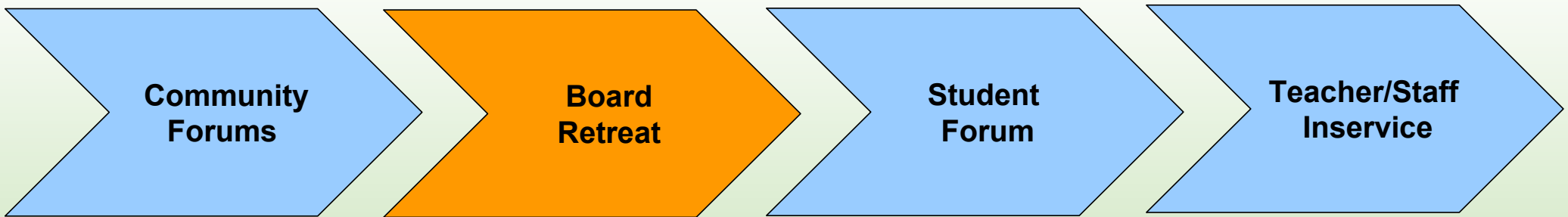


Goal of the Community Forums:

Strategic Planning Process Overview/Timeline

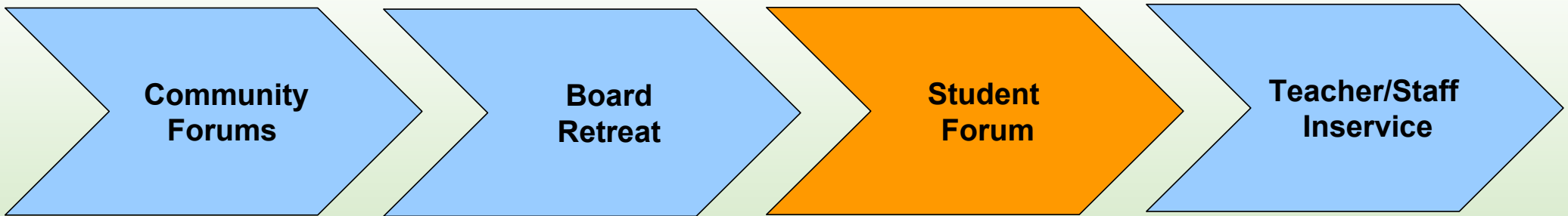


Goal of the Board Retreat:

Strategic Planning Process Overview/Timeline

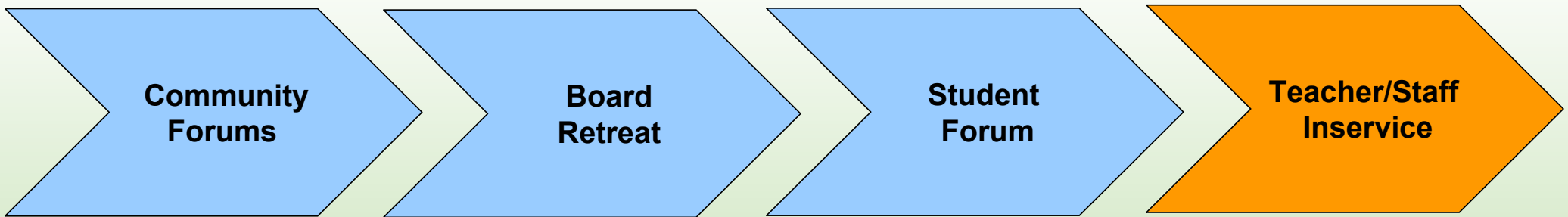


Goal of the Student Forum:

- Curiosity and Creativity





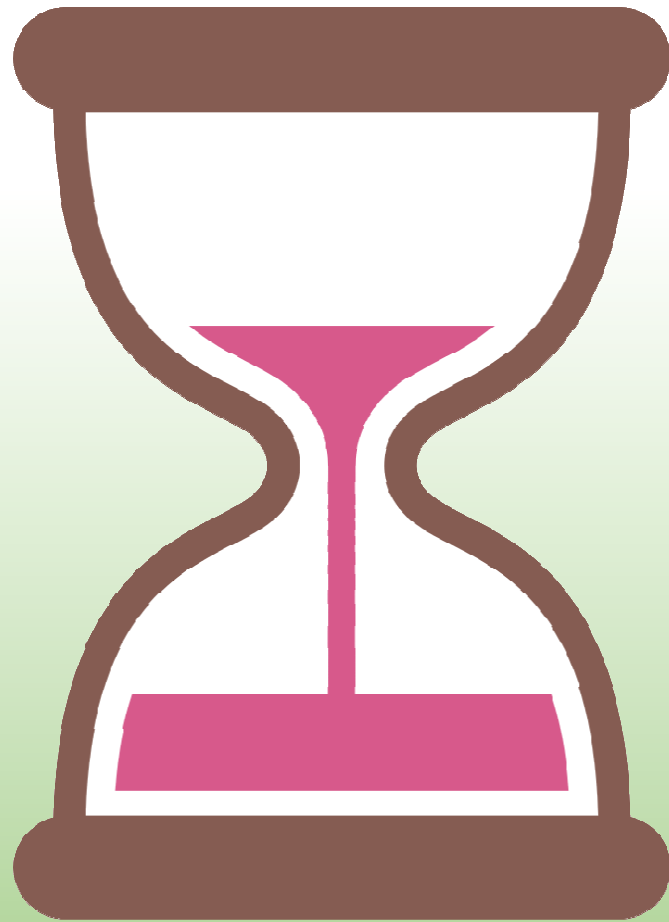
Vision and Mission
